Clause 2 of the Bill would amend section 4 of the Act to add the exemptions currently contained in the Lobbyist Registration Exemption Regulations to the Act and extend the non-application provisions of the Act to activities as related to the St. John's Municipal Council, the City of St. John's and entities controlled by the city.

						<p>Clauses 3 and 4 of the Bill would amend sections 5 and 6 of the Act to require lobbyist return information to include similar or equivalent activities as related to the St. John's Municipal Council, the City of St. John's and entities controlled by the city.</p> <p>Clause 5 of the Bill would amend the Act to extend the one year lobbying restriction currently applying to government former public-office holders to equivalent positions in the St. John's Municipal Council, the City of St. John's and entities controlled by the city in relation to lobbying public office holders of the St. John's Municipal Council, the City of St. John's and entities controlled by the city.</p> <p>Clause 6 of the Bill would amend section 21 of the Act to change "governmental institution" to "public institution" to recognize the inclusion in the Act of the St. John's Municipal Council, the City of St. John's, and entities controlled by the city.</p> <p>Clause 7 of the Bill of the Act would repeal the Lobbyist Registration Exemption Regulations as a consequence of the amendment proposed in clause 2 of the Bill.</p> <p>Clause 8 of the Bill would bring the Act into force on January 1, 2009.</p>
