New Brunswick 56th Legislature, 16 2nd Session
An Act to Amend the Motor Vehicle Act

1st Reading – November 30, 2007
 The Act is amended to make changes to the driver licensing process, specifically novice drivers. A novice driver will not be able to have more passengers than seatbelts, not more than one person in the front seat, and restrictions on driving hours and blood alcohol levels.

Anyone under the age of 18 who applies for a licence must have written consent.

82 Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act

First Reading - June 5, 2008
 The purposes of this Act are to make public bodies accountable to the public and to protect the privacy of the public by (a) allowing any person a right of access to records in the custody or under the control of public bodies, subject to the limited and specific exceptions set out in this Act,

(b) allowing individuals a right of access to records containing personal information about themselves in the custody or under the control of public bodies, subject to the limited and specific exceptions set out in this Act, (c) allowing individuals a right to request corrections to records containing personal information about themselves in the custody or under the control of public bodies, (d) controlling the manner in which public bodies may collect personal information from individuals and protecting individuals against unauthorized use or disclosure of personal information by public bodies, and (e) providing for an independent review of the decisions of public bodies under this Act.
